Note to parents: You'll notice that all of the female words use "die" for "the" and all of the masculine words use "der" for "the." Nouns in German have a gender (masculine, feminine, and neuter) and the gender determines which article (form of "the") to use. However, if the noun is an object in a sentence, the article might change in form. You'll notice, too, that nouns in German are


