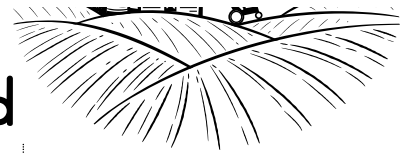
In other languages, words have genders. You will see two different words that mean "the farmer." One is the male version of farmer and the other is the female version of farmer.

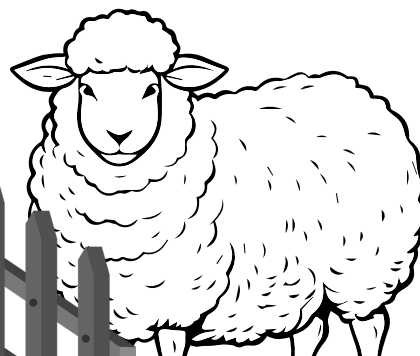
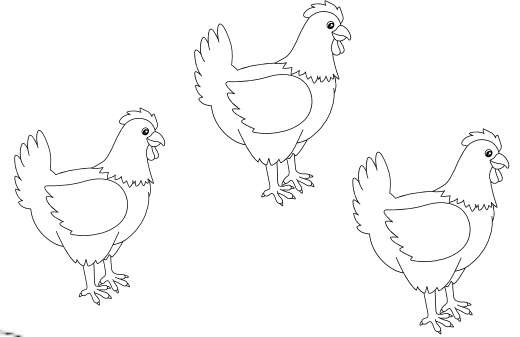
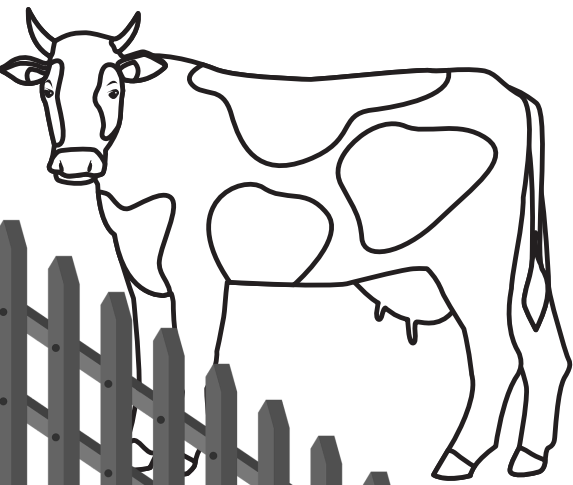
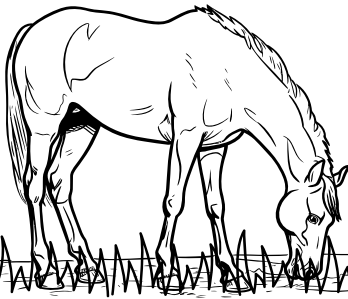
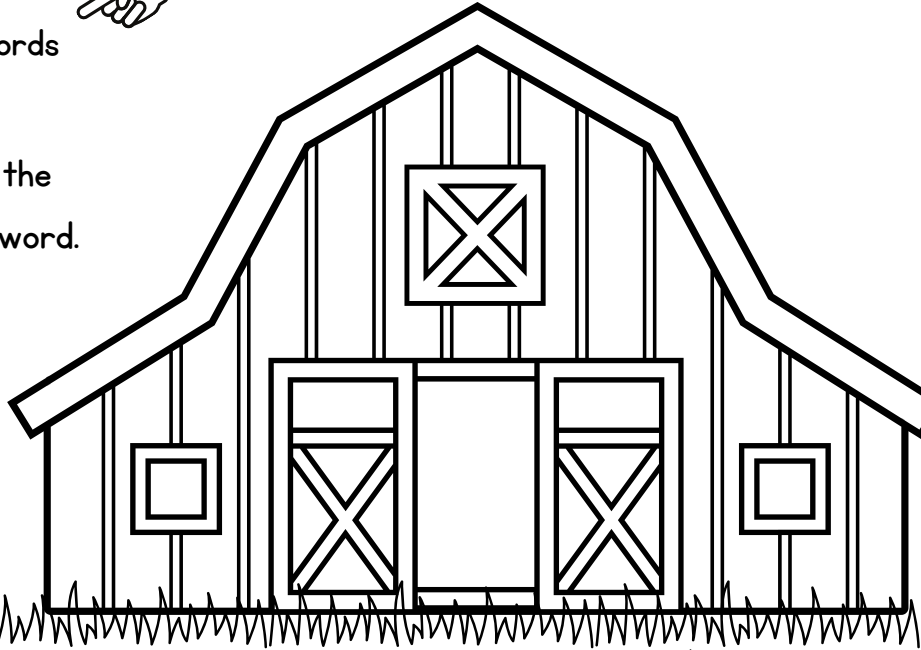
Color the picture of the farm.
